

Important update:
If you own or owned a Carrier, Bryant, Payne or Day & Night gas furnace manufactured in December 1988 you could get benefits from a class action settlement.

A nationwide settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit about whether Carrier Corporation ("Carrier") failed to disclose alleged defects in the secondary heat exchangers of its high efficiency gas furnaces. The settlement provides benefits to those who own or owned a high efficiency gas furnace.

Although your legal rights are not affected by the settlement, you may be eligible to receive benefits if you own or owned a Carrier, Bryant, Payne or Day & Night high efficiency gas furnace with a PPL secondary heat exchanger that was manufactured in December 1988.

*Only those with serial numbers 4988, 5088, 5188, or 5288 in the first four positions (i.e. 4988xxxxxx) are eligible for benefits.

If you still own your gas furnace, you will automatically receive an enhanced 20-year warranty and you may request a payment for up to \$270 for a past secondary heat exchanger failure.

To request a payment for a past secondary heat exchanger failure you must complete and submit a claim form. You can submit a claim form at www.FurnaceClaims.com. The claim form describes what you must provide to prove your claim and receive a payment. Please read the instructions carefully, fill out the claim form, and submit it online or mail it postmarked no later than **August 1, 2008** to the address on the form.
